4. Anytime before Monday, November 20th, bring non-perishable food items to the parish center including: ***canned goods including cranberry sauce, gravy, peas, corn, green beans, tomato products, soup, tuna, beans, and coffee; dried pasta, jars of peanut butter, and boxed stuffing.***

By including non-traditional food items, we provide food to needy families for the entire Thanksgiving weekend. The needs of the homeless in our community have, unfortunately, grown. This project offers a wonderful opportunity for each member of the family to participate in various ways from purchasing food items to sorting, packaging and delivering the items.
